We are excited about our upcoming presentation of Disney's The Aristocats Kids on November 12th and 13th. The cast will be a combination of first, second and third grade Lakeview students. The 4th and 5th graders will perform a different play rehearsing Jan.- Mar. with a show in mid March. If your child is interested in joining our cast please fill out the registration form that will come home this **Friday, August 21st** and return it as soon as **Monday, August 24th**. The first 45 students that turn in their registration form with full payment are guaranteed a spot in the play. Students will be invited to audition for parts. No parents at the auditions please. More information to come via email regarding auditions.

The play will be directed by Kitty Czarnecki, executive director of Art & Soul. Czarnecki is a former co-owner of Garbeau's Dinner Theater and has directed locally. She is a substitute teacher in the Buckeye and Rescue school districts. Kitty encourages all students to be involved in all aspects of the production. Rehearsals will take place on Tue. & Thurs. from 3-5pm starting September 14th. Principals will have an additional rehearsal on Mondays.

Parent participation is required or \$50 buy out option.

Listed below are the jobs /committees to be filled:

Stage Manager: in charge of back stage, assist Kitty with kids during rehearsals.

Student Director: attend rehearsals and work backstage

Musical Director: be able to read music, singing a plus. Attend first 2 weeks of rehearsals.

Choreography: dance experience a plus (could be a high school student)

Technical Support: attend rehearsals 3 weeks prior to play, prepare equipment.

Costumer: help collect costume pieces like hats and specialty items. Using recycled items is recommended.

Program Support: conduct contest for 1st-3rd grades to design front cover of program. Publish and print program.

Props and Set Director: help create props and set. Cast members, to be involved.

Publicity: write and submit press release for local newspaper, create signs and flyers to promote attendance.

Concessions: organize volunteers, and all items for concession stand.

T-shirts: cast members to receive a t-shirt, design and have cast members names printed.
