- ❖ If you see your child scratching his head frequently you might want to check for lice. Head lice continues to be a problem statewide and we have had several cases at Lakeview. Head to head contact or, less frequently an exchange of hats, clothing, combs, brushes, barrettes, scarves and other personal items can transmit lice from an infested child to others. Our school district has a "no nit" policy, so a child that has had lice needs to be cleared through the office before returning to classes. For further information on inspecting, treatment, nit removal, lice biology and housecleaning recommendations contact the school nurse.
