### **Announcements:**

- ❖ Rescue School is proud to announce that Montessori classrooms, preschool through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, will be available to the children of Rescue School District in 2010/2011! All K-2 classes begin at 8:55 a.m. with kindergarten ending at 1 p.m. and other grades ending at 3:00 p.m. Extended Day Care is offered before and after school for all students. In a Montessori program students increase their own knowledge through self and teacher initiated experiences in which teachers take on the role of guides and children direct their own learning. Students learn by manipulating materials and interacting with others. The program will be standards based with grade level assessments and report cards used as measures. The students will participate in STAR testing as well. You may indicate your desire for a Montessori classroom by filling out the Montessori Preference Form in the 2010/11 enrollment packet at your home school. Enrollment packets will be available beginning February 1, 2010. Completed enrollment packets must be submitted to your home school and will be accepted starting February 12, 2010.
